Savage Stone Aids Local Food Relief Efforts at Ridgely's Run Community Center



Savage Stone is proud to support the Ridgely's Run Community Center in its mission to combat food insecurity within the quarry corridor. Throughout the past year, our team has assisted in distributing approximately 4,000 food boxes—averaging nearly 400 boxes per month—to neighbors in need. While the program was proudly spearheaded by the Howard County MLK Jr. Holiday Commission and the Harriet Tubman Foundation for many years, Savage Stone has worked closely with Ridgely's Run to ensure these essential services continue uninterrupted after the expiration of original grant funding.
